1. REUSABLE WATER BOTTLES:

Kauai water is great – no need to buy cases of plastic bottled water!

2. REEF-SAFE SUNSCREEN: Sunscreens containing oxybenzone and octinoxate damage our fragile reefs.

3. BINOCULARS: View seals and turtles from afar so they can get the important rest they need while on the beach.

4. OLD CLOTH GROCERY BAGS & GARDEN GLOVES:

5. REUSABLE TRAVEL UTENSILS: Just say no to plastic takeout utensils and straws!
